

Privacy policy

Personal data

Personal information is information that can be used to identify you as a specific individual; for example, your name, address, email address or telephone number. If during your visit you submit your personal information in any way, personal information may be collected and used to communicate with you for any purposes.

ASTARTA may appoint third-party organizations to assist in providing you with the information, goods, products and services you request. In these circumstances, steps will be taken to ensure that your personal information is held in strict accordance with our privacy policy and is used only for the purpose of fulfilling your request. ASTARTA does not sell or distribute your personal information to third parties for the purposes of allowing them to market their products and services to you.

Personal data collected by ASTARTA may be transferred, including in the future, among its various divisions and subsidiary companies around the world. By submitting data on the Site, the visitor is providing explicit consent to these transfers, including cross-border transmission of data covered by this Privacy Statement.

Automatically collected data

The domain name and IP address of visitors are logged automatically. This data is not personal information and it does not identify you as an individual; it only contains information about the computer that is being used to view the Site. Such data is used to see where the Site is being used in the world to ensure coverage, and for click-stream analysis to help better understand Site usage. ASTARTA does not link information automatically logged by such means with personal data about specific individuals.

However, personal information might inadvertently be collected due to automatic functions in the third-party commercial software used in the operation of ASTARTA servers. If it is discovered that such a collection has taken place then reasonable steps will be taken to remove it from ASTARTA's systems.

Data retention

Data will be held for the lifetime your subscription is active for the purposes of contacting you effectively, after which time it is depersonalised and non-identifiable. We do not collect any additional information about you other than that outlined above.

Cookies

Some information (commonly known as a 'cookie') may be stored on your computer when you view or use this Site. This information facilitates your use of the Site and ensures that you do not need to re-enter your details every time you visit it. You can erase or block this information from your computer if you wish; your user manual or help files should give instructions on how to do this.

Opt-out/modification of information

Security

We are implementing security policies, rules and technical measures to protect the personal data that we have under our control. These comply fully with the data privacy and protection legislation appropriate to the jurisdiction applicable to the Site. The security measures are designed to prevent access, improper use or disclosure, modification and unlawful destruction or accidental loss. At present we do not give visitors to our Site the option of using a secure transmission method to send us their personal data.

Children

This Site is neither directed nor targeted at children. ASTARTA will not knowingly collect information from children.
